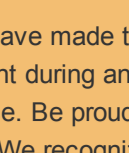

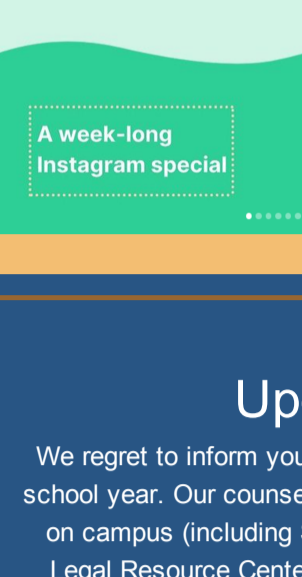

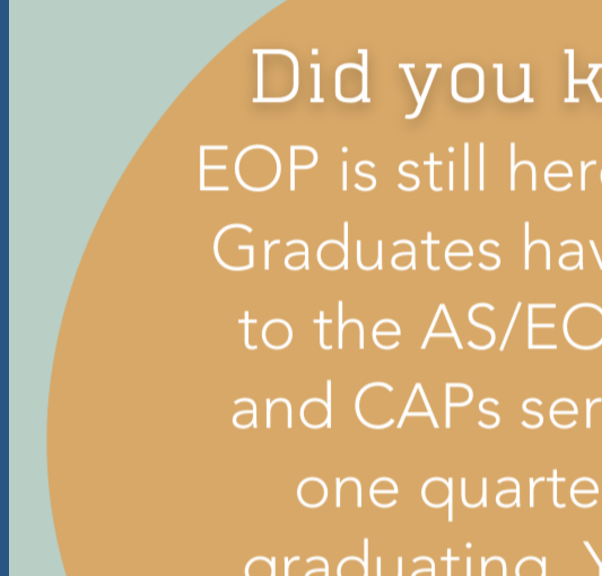
FROM EOP

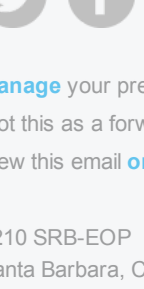
