THE HALAL & KOSHER FOOD DONATION COORDINATOR

\$15/hr.

The Halal & Kosher Food Donation Program Coordinator will help to implement a program which aims to support low income students who are keeping Halal & Kosher diets in accessing healthy food that meets their dietary restrictions. This program was first piloted in Spring 2019 and serves over 50 students. Students participating in this program receive a grocery bag each week containing items that are Halal and Kosher. These bags are meant to supplement other items that can be found at the Associated Students Food Bank that are Halal and Kosher. This coordinator will manage applications to the program, determine what items each bag will contain, will research the items to ensure that they meet appropriate Halal and Kosher standards, and will oversee the logistics of ordering, picking up items, bagging items, and delivering items to distribution location(s). The intern will also help to facilitate interfaith collaborations between the Halal and Kosher communities around food security and food justice.

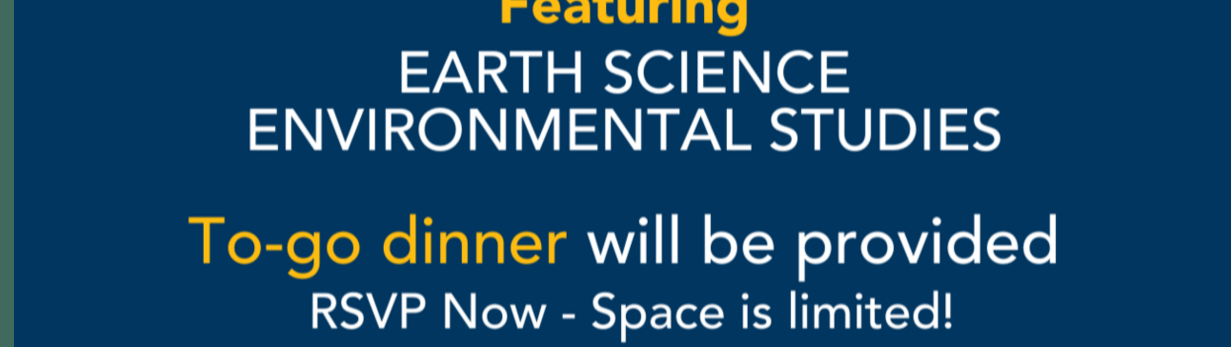

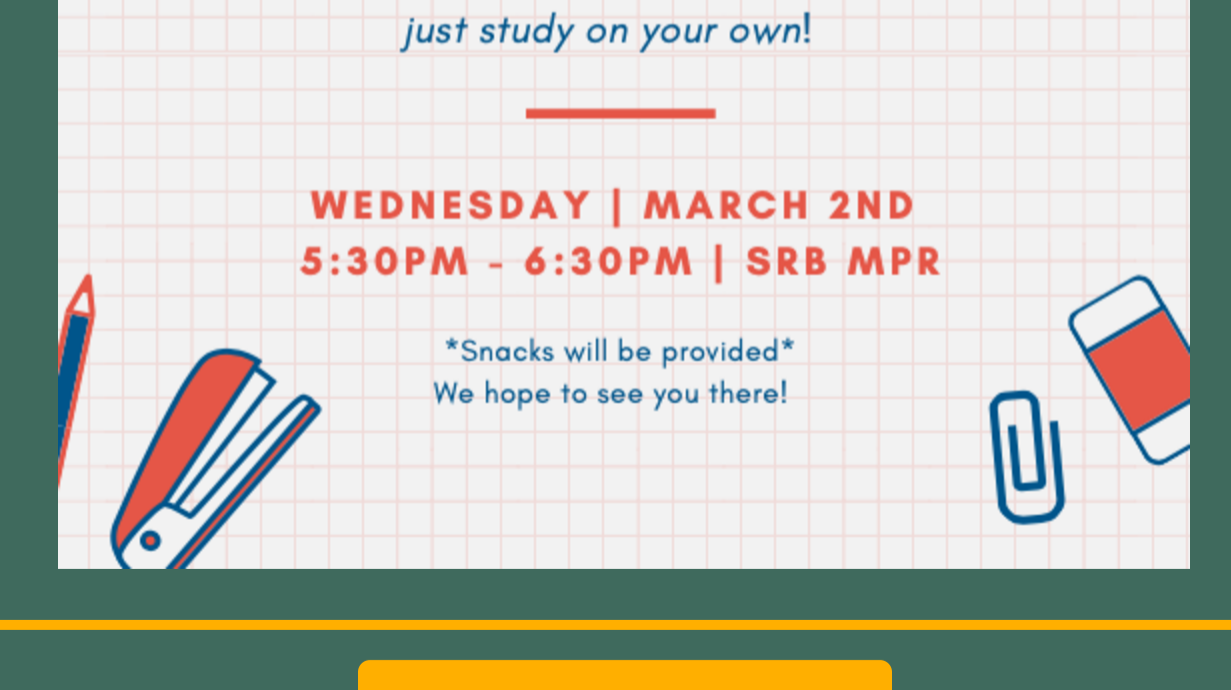

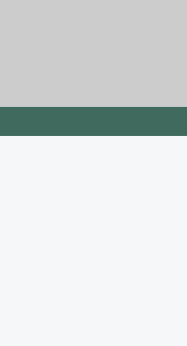
