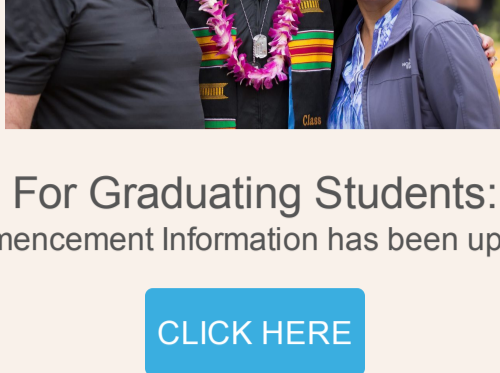

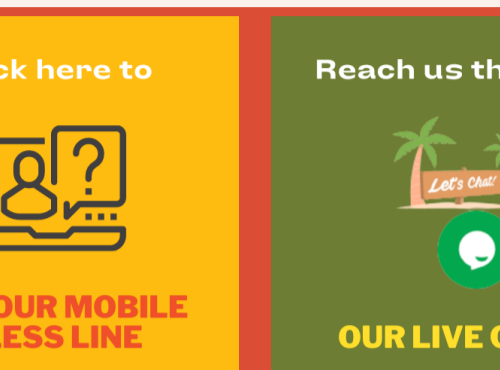
Keep going, Gaucho!

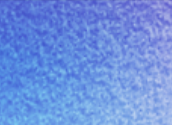

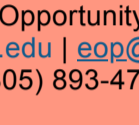
